PLANNING MEET

The planning meet of the examination committee for the academic year (2022-2023) was conducted on 1.12.2022 at 4 pm in the college. All the members of the committee were present in the meeting and the following important decisions were taken after discussion.

- ✓ TNTEU altered the B.ED two year programme into semester pattern from this academic year 2022.
- ✓ Each student result shall also be declared in terms of grades.
- ✓ The cumulative grade point Average (GCPA) at the end of all the semester examinations shall be calculated as the weighted average of the semester grade point averages.
- ✓ Alpha sign grades A+, A, B, C and D denotes successful completion of the programme. The grade F denotes failed in the programme and requires for reappearance in the exam.
- ✓ The question paper pattern also changed into objective type, short answer and essay type.
- ✓ The plan to conduct more objective type test and weekly test.
- ✓ After completing the unit, it is compulsory conduct the unit test using the question paper pattern that university suggested.
- ✓ The correction of the answer sheets must be completed within 4 days from the date of examination.

- ✓ The feedback should be given to the students by the concerned staff members.
- ✓ The teacher educators must enter the marks in the staff computer (excel sheet) compulsorily.

MODEL EXAMINATION

Model Examination was conducted for the B.Ed. I year, M.Ed. I year (First semester), M.Ed. II year (3rd Semester) from 31.1.2023 to 08.02.2023. This examination was conducted in the manner just like the University centralized examination. The students seats were arranged as per the examination register number order and two halls were used to accommodate all the students. The time table and supervision schedule were planned and executed by the Examination Committee.

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

The 3rd semester practical examination conducted for B.Ed II year (2020-2023) by TNTEU, on March 10 and 11. The External examiners were Dr. Rajan., Principal, Sri Vidhya College of Education, ViruthuNagar and Dr. R. Ayyanar , Assistant Professor, Srividhya Vihar College of Education, Thiruppachavadi Medu, Villupuram.

The I and III semester External examination for both B.Ed. and M.Ed. was directed TNTEU university from 17.04.2023 to 21.04.2023

MODEL EXAMINATION

The Model Examination for IInd and IVth semester was conducted in the month of June from 16.06.2023 to 21.06.2023.

FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES

The corrected papers and marks were collected within 4 days from the date of conduct of the examination. All the marks were verified to get the list of poor performers and high performers. The low achievers were warned and special attention was given to them to clarify their doubts. Academic counseling and remedial teaching was given for selected candidates. High achievers were further encouraged to secure good marks and ranks in the ensuing University Examination.

EXAMINATION RESULT

On 22.06.2023, TNTEU released the result for B.Ed., M.Ed. students for the I and III semester, the students acquired the 99 % result.

The evaluation meeting of the Examination Committee was organized on 26.06.23 to evaluate the various activities of the Examination Committee .The Committee members felt that they have done their duty systematically in a regular manner. All the Unit Tests, Model Examination were carried out as per the plan. The various responsibilities of the Examination Committee were executed in an orderly way throughout the year.

Suggestions for the next academic year:

1. Slow learners were identified after the first Unit test and individual attention was given. Instead a special time may be allotted for them from the beginning of the course to clarify their doubts or to spend more time for the hard nuts in their curriculum.
2. Unit test may be given as new type tests as online tests, objective tests, viva-voce, Computer Based Tests, Computerized Tests and open book examination. The university question pattern can be followed in the Model Examination. The daily tests are also preparing the students for writing the essay type questions.
3. All the examinations and tests except the Model Examination can be conducted in the major class itself for the ease in invigilation.
4. The next academic year the students must be get centum result and score highest marks.
